
Talk series "Women of Passion and Achievement"-

As a part of empowering women through knowledge and awareness, the Women Empowerment cell, GITAM has started a talk series called "Women of Passion and Achievement" with accomplished women to know about the effort and determination it took to make it all possible! 1St in the series is an enlightening session with Dr. Priyadarshini Ghosh, an accomplished Indian Classical and Contemporary dancer and dance scholar, Visiting Lecturer, Theatre Arts, and Performance Studies, at Brown University, and Artistic Director, at Natyanova Performing Arts Centre.

A wonderful session was conducted on 25th January 2023 from 10 to 11 am at VDC. With about 25 students from different institutes and faculty, both women and men attended the event. Dr. Ghosh talked about the presence and significance given to Women in performance arts through the ages and in different parts of India. She also highlighted the various benefits of dance and performing arts as a means of expression, finding identity, and rehabilitation for women traumatized in different settings. Dr. Ghosh also mentioned the role and effects of Dance, Movement Therapy (DMT) in rehabilitation.
